We now leave the church building and go to the school building. The first room you come to is the **SECRETARY'S OFFICE**. The Secretary has on a judge's robe and is holding a gavel. She is known to be quite unfair. A very **Persistent Widow** is standing on the other side of the desk begging to get what she needs, and because the widow keeps pleading, the judge finally gives in and gives the widow what she wants. If an unfair judge will give what you need, how much more will our God take care of his own who cry to him day & night.

37. BAND ROOM - Pharisee & Publican - 00, 18, 0

When you enter the <u>BAND ROOM</u> you see that two are having "Chair Try Outs". The <u>Publican</u> is quietly looking at his horn over in one corner bowed in deep humility. However, the <u>Pharisee</u> boldly states "He that tooteth not his own horn, the same shall not be tooted."

38. MATH ROOM - Laborers in Vineyard - 20, 0 0 0

As you come into the <u>MATH - ACCOUNTING ROOM</u>, you see 6 clocks up on the wall. They are trying to figure up how much each worker should be paid if the first clock showed early, the next clock showed the 3rd hour of the day, another said 6th hour of the day, another the 11th hour and finally one had only worked one hour. Quite a problem , but they learn that <u>all</u> workers get the same amount of money

39. CAFETERIA - The Ten Pounds - 00, 19, 0

Now you enter the <u>CAFETERIA</u>, which is Room #39 where you can get a bite to eat. In fact you can eat so much that you gain <u>Ten</u>

<u>Pounds</u>. Ten servants have each been given one pound. The first servant took his pound and gained 10 more. The second servant's pound increased to 5 more. However, the last servant <u>hid</u> his <u>under his napkin</u> and only returned the one pound which he had been given and had no increase.

40. SPEECH OR DEBATE ROOM - Two Sons - 21, 0 0 0

You go out the other door of the cafeteria & come up another hallway. The first room you come to is **THE SPEECH OR DEBATE ROOM**. Two sons are in there debating on who did the will of their Father. They are 40 year old twins and their names are "Will" and "Won't". Will said "I'll go work" but then he didn't go. Won't said he wouldn't go work, but changed his mind and went to work. The debate is **Who Did The Will of the Father?**

41. SUPERINTENDENT'S OFFICE - Vineyard, Tower & Wicked Husbandmen - 21, 12, 20, 0

A Householder has planted a vineyard, built a tower and a winepress and has left it in charge of the <u>SUPERINTENDENT</u>. When the crop was harvested, the owner sent his students to collect, but the <u>wicked SUPERINTENDENT</u> beat & sometimes killed them. He then sent his son, but he was killed also. So the owner comes and destroys the <u>WICKED SUPERINTENDENT</u> and gives the vineyard to others.

42. ANNUAL STAFF ROOM - Marriage of King's Son - 22, 0 0 0

In the <u>ANNUAL STAFF ROOM</u> you see 6 tables (four on one side of the room & two on the other) with piles of things on them getting ready for publication. The first table has pictures of the <u>King's Son</u> in his wedding garment. The 2nd table has <u>Invitations</u> for the wedding and feast. The 3rd table is littered with piles of <u>Letters of Excuses</u>. The 4th table has pictures of <u>Highways & Byways</u> inviting Bad & Good. The 5th table has a picture of a man with <u>No Wedding Garment</u> on. The 6thth table has a large poster that reads "<u>Many are called but Few</u> Chosen.

43. SHOP - Leaves of Fig Tree and Other Trees - 24, 13, 21, 0

Piles of wood are in the <u>SHOP ROOM</u>. In fact you see trees that are still growing around the corners of the room. The teacher is trying to prepare them for the destruction of Jerusalem. He says they are wise enough to know that when they see tender <u>leaves on the trees</u>, it is time for summer. The same way, if they are observant, they will know the time of the coming destruction. This generation shall not die before..."

44. ART ROOM - Householder Watching - 25,000

In the <u>ART ROOM</u> stands a man nicknamed "four eyes", because of this thick glasses (room #44), staring at the four big paintings on the walls. The first wall has a painting of a <u>Man Shielding His Eyes and watching the Road</u>. The second wall has a painting of the <u>Stars & the Moon at Midnight</u>. The third wall has a painting of a <u>Cock Crowing at Sunup</u>. The fourth wall has a painting of the Sun High in the Sky. No one knows the hour when the Lord will come, so always be watching.

45. HOME ECONOMICS ROOM — Ten Virgins — 25, 0 0 0

Naturally in the <u>HOME ECONOMICS ROOM</u> you'll find <u>Ten Bridal Dresses</u> being made. This is the parable of the <u>Ten Virgins</u> where five are prepared for the bridegroom's return and five are not.

46. GYM - Talents - 25,000
